ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 28, 1965, at Santa Fe, New Maxico, before Examiner Daniel S. Eutter.

NOW, on this 622 day of August, 1965, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Emminer, and being fully advised in the premises.

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Bolack-Greer, Inc., seeks an exception to the well location requirements of the Special Rules and Regulations governing the Puerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool for its Canada Ojitos Unit Well No. 8 located 850 feet from the North line and 1030 feet from the East line of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 1 West, EMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the subject well was drilled at the above-described non-standard location in order to avoid topographic difficulties that would be encountered at a standard location in the NE/4 of said Section 16.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable

share of the oil in the pool, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE CADERED:

- (1) That the applicant, Bolack-Greer, Inc., is hereby granted an exception to the well location requirements of the Special Rules and Regulations governing the Puerto Chiquito-Gallup Oil Pool for its Canada Ojitos Unit Well Bo. 8 located 850 feet from the North line and 1030 feet from the Mast line of Section 16, Township 25 North, Range 1 West, NMPM, Ric Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
