

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Continental Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on January 14, 1966, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache 20 Well No. 4 located in Unit K of Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup Formation and the Dakota Formation.

Now, on this 3rd day of February, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objection have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

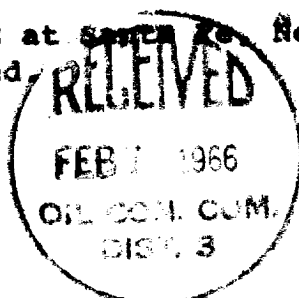
That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Apache 20 Well No. 4 located in Unit K of Section 18, Township 25 North, Range 4 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup Formation and the Dakota Formation through one string of 2 3/8-inch tubing with separation of zones by dual-flow downhole choke assembly set at approximately 6865 feet and a packer set at approximately 7700 feet.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter on the anniversary date of completion of the well.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
