The above well was spudded on October 25, 1962. Hole was drilled to a depth of 210' and 8-5/8" casing set at that depth with 135 sacks of neat Inner cement containing 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated to surface. After waiting on cement tested casing with 500 pounds. Test o.k. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 200' and resumed drilling.
