E. H. Haggie Well No. 1. Perforated Gallup with four shots per foot 5356-5384, 5396-5412. Sand oil fracked with 38,400 gallons oil and 50,000 pounds sand. Breakdown pressure 2650 pounds, average treating pressure 2450 pounds, average injection rate 37 barrels per minute. Landed 2" tubing at 5364'. Ran rods and pump. Released completion unit on June 4, 1959. Well is currently recovering, load oil during completion operations.
