Well was drilled by Kenneth Marchison in 1956. 9-5/8" surface casing set @ 120' w/190 sx. cement. 5-1/2" production casing @ 4530' w/200 sx. cement. Gallup section perforated 4318' to 4338' & 4436' to 4444' and sand-oil fractured. Completed on Feb. 26, 1957 for 10 EGPA and 39.7 MCFGPD.

Well was subsequently sold to El Paso Natural Gas Products Company in August of 1957 and was operated by them.

An Assignment of Leases, executed May 3, 1958, records this property being assigned to Gas Producers Corporation. The well was subsequently temporarily abandoned at that time.

Subsequently in April, 1962, the Gas Producers Corporation was sold to the present owners and the operations assumed by them. An exhaustive search has been made of old records and numerous inquiries made over the last few years to ascertain information on the plugging of this well. Nothing has been found. On April 23, 1964, the well site was visited and the well has been plugged and a dry hole marker is cemented in place. There were no pits or other harmful aspects pertaining to the well site. The individuals that may have directed the plugging of this well, Mr. E. F. Cessinger and Mr. Q. J. Lilly, are deceased.
