
Gentlemen

Enclosed please find a corrected copy of USGS Form 9-330, Well Completion Report, for the captioned well. The original completion report for this well indicated the well was duly completed as a gas-gas dual in the McCracken (Devonian) and the Quartzite (Pre-Cambrian?). It is felt the McCracken and the Quartzite, a fractured weathered rock, are a common source of gas supply in this well. The enclosed corrected report shows the well as a single completion.

Also enclosed are copies of NMOCC Form C-102 dedicating the 160 acres in the Southeast Quarter of Section 34 to this gas completion, and a tabulation of the deviation surveys run on the well.
