

Dear Sir:

Petro-Lewis Corporation recently acquired the Federal 27-43 from KENAI Corporation. The well is located in Section 27, Township 24 North, Range 9 West. The well was completed on April 1, 1982.

This is an application for a Special Well Test of the Federal 27-43. The application is being made to establish the production of the subject well. The production data obtained during the Special Well Test will be used to either justify the economics of a gas sales system or to apply for venting according to NTL-4A Section 4B #1. Petro-Lewis Corporation does not feel that the 30 day test conducted on this well is sufficient to establish production of the Federal 27-43.

The subject well is not under a gas contract at the present time. Two gas pipelines exist in the area of the Federal 27-43. The first is an El Paso Natural Gas low-pressure line located to the north of the subject well. A sales line of approximately 10,000' would be needed to tie into this line. El Paso Natural Gas is not accepting new gas contracts of any type at the present time. The second gas pipeline is a Gas Company of New Mexico high-pressure line located to the southwest of the subject well. A sales line of approximately 7500' and a gas compressor would be needed to tie into this line.



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The Federal 27-43 is presently completed in the Gallup formation. The Gallup formation often declines rapidly immediately after completion. Specific examples of the rapid decline are as follows:
