Reference is made to your letter of July 10, 1956 concerning the necessity for filing a request for a non-standard gas promotion unit for the above captioned well inasmuch as Mr. Humblin had advised Mr. Jason Kallishin that El Paso Natural Gas Company did not own the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 20.

On Form C-128 El Paso Natural Gas Company is shown as the operator of the tract dedicated to this well. This is correct inasmuch as the well is located on a committed tract consisting of the entire SE/4. As far as actual lease ownership is concerned, El Paso Natural Gas Company holds a lease on the SW/4 SE/4 only. The N/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 are held by Mr. Ed Conroy and two associates.

El Paso Natural Gas Company is designated in the approved Commitment Agreement as the operator of the committed tract. Therefore, the acreage dedicated to the Sanchez #1 Well constitutes a standard gas promotion unit.
