ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 25, 1961, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla "B" Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMMP, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Tapacio-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 25th day of May, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds;

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Socony Mobil Oil Company, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "B" Well No. 2 located in the NE/4 NE/4 of Section 19, Township 26 North, Range 3 West, NMMP, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Tapacio-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.
