Gentlemen:


We were recently instructed by the Santa Fe Office of the Oil Conservation Commission to keep our Breece A D-204 well, Unit P Section 9-26N-6W, shut in until they notified us otherwise, because it was more than six times overproduced.

This well is a dual Dakota-Tocito producer and its annual packer leakage test was started June 24, 1961. The Tocito zone flowed during the period July 1 to July 8. The Dakota zone is scheduled to flow July 16 to July 24.

Inasmuch as the test is half finished it would be to the advantage of the operator and purchaser to complete it as scheduled. Permission is therefore requested to flow the well July 16 to July 24 to complete the test.
