

THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED  
OIL & GAS, INC., FOR A DUAL  
COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1417

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 19, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Jicarilla Well No. 4-8 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 4th day of November, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations:
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc. be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla Well No. 4-8 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

THE APPLICATION TO COMBINE  
THE GAS, INC., AND A GAS  
COMBINATION.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A, Consolidated Oil  
Gas, Inc., was application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation  
Commission on October 19, 1963, for permission to drill complete  
a Biscuit Well No. 4-5 located in Unit E of Section 8, Town-  
ship 24 North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico,  
in such a manner as to produce gas from the South Biscuit-  
Cilla Pool and the Biscuit-Messavada Pool.

Now, on this 1st day of November, 1963, the Secretary  
Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the  
provisions of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations
- (2) That sufficient information has been provided  
that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the  
writing period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause  
waste nor violate correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion  
feasible and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc.  
be and the same is hereby authorized to drill complete the  
Biscuit Well No. 4-5 located in Unit E of Section 8, Township 24  
North, Range 2 West, NMM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such  
a manner as to produce gas from the South Biscuit-  
Cilla Pool and the Biscuit-Messavada Pool through a dual completion of  
the well.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, that applicant shall complete, operate,  
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule  
11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, that applicant shall make, enter,  
leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the  
annual well flow test period for the Biscuit-Messavada Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That production of this cause  
is hereby restricted to the entry of such further orders as the  
Commission may deem necessary.
