AINCHISTRATIVE OFDET OF THE OIL CONSERNATION CONTISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Southern Union Production
Company made application to the New Hexico Oil Conservation Commission
on October 37, 1977, for permission to duality complete its Jicarilla "G"
Well Ho. I located in Unit L of Section 1, Trumship 26 North, Range 5
West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a marner as to produce
gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 19th day of November, 1877, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filled under the provisions of Tula 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objection: have been received within the waiting pariod as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor invair correlative rights.
- (5) That the machanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Southern Union Production Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Jicarilla "G" Well No. 1 located in Unit L of Section 1, Township 26 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
