

THE APPLICATION OF CAULKINS OIL
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2165

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Caulkins Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 9, 1974, for permission to dually complete its Breech D Well No. 387 located in Unit O of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation adjacent to the Otero-Chacra Pool.

NOW, on this 30th day of December, 1974, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Caulkins Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Breech D Well No. 387 located in Unit O of Section 22, Township 26 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and from the Chacra Formation adjacent to the Otero-Chacra Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

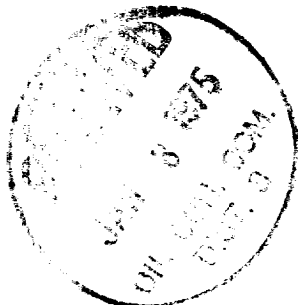
PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
