In followup to your letter dated July 12, 2000 and our subsequent meeting on August 23, 2000, this letter discusses Merrion's plans for using the subject (and other) wells in the Canyon Largo Unit Gallup PA for a waterflood. Specifically, Merrion requests that the subject wells (and other wells in the future, if necessary) be allowed to remain temporarily abandoned (or shut in if that is the case) for the near future. The following arguments are presented to support our request.

- 1. Enclosed is a report of a reservoir simulation study performed to evaluate the potential for a waterflood in the Canyon Largo Unit Gallup Formation. The report indicates that a waterflood is technically feasible, but economically marginal at the \$18 oil price assumed in the economics. While oil prices are currently well above \$18/bbl, the futures strip shows prices returning to near that level within two years. Merrion must have confidence that prices will be sustained above \$25/bbl before we would implement a waterflood pilot.
- 2. The waterflood will be extremely capital intensive and will require the use of all existing wellbores combined with additional infill drilling. Even at higher prices, we may not be able to justify the waterflood if we don't have the existing wellbores to use.
- 3. Again, the waterflood will require infilling the field on 80 acre or perhaps 40 acre spacing. Because of the current Resource Management Plan review (RMP), we couldn't do the waterflood right now anyway, even if we wanted to.
- 4. If the existing wells are allowed to be left in place, that would leave their surface locations available if needed during the RMP review period to be used to drill to other formations.
- 5. While Merrion is not ready to implement a waterflood now, or even in the next two years, we think the time will come in the next ten years to install that flood. That, however, may never happen if we are forced to plug out the existing wells. Therefore, the long-term interests of the mineral owners (which is mostly Federal in the Unit) are best served by not forcing Merrion to abandon these locations.

Below is a list of wells in the Canyon Largo Unit Gallup PA that ultimately may be used in the waterflood. We request that, should any of these existing producing wells require it, they be given similar consideration as the four subject wells.
