Dear Sir:

On July 29, 1957, we received your acknowledgement of our original Notice of Intention to Drill dated July 3, 1957, covering the Alfred Eaton No. 2 well located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30-25E-10W, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, Wildcat Pool.

Under the provisions of the Oil & Gas Operating regulations this Notice of Intention to Drill on the above mentioned well would be rescinded after 90 days, if operations were not commenced.

We respectfully request that permission to drill the above mentioned well be extended an additional 30 days, by which time we feel sure that drilling operations will be started. Our delay in beginning these operations in the past was due to difficulty in obtaining a drilling rig.

If approval can not be extended for an additional 30 days, please advise and we will resubmit these forms.
