This well was temporarily abandoned 12-8-60 as uneconomical to produce and because of proposed formation of Unit. Because of increase production from the No. 1 well on this lease and delay of the unit, we propose to attempt to resume production from this well. Perforations are 5107'-5113' and 5122'-5136' in the Gallup Formation. We propose to acidize these perforation with 500 gallons Mud Acid, run rods and pump, and attempt to produce this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
