4. Cement 4-1/2" casing at 4975'± with 150 sacks construction cement.
5. Clean out to 4965'±.
6. Perforate four 1/2" holes/ft gross interval 4900'± - 4965'±.
7. Sand oil fracture with 30,000 gal crude oil and 1-2 #/gal sand.
8. Make production test, establish initial rate.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

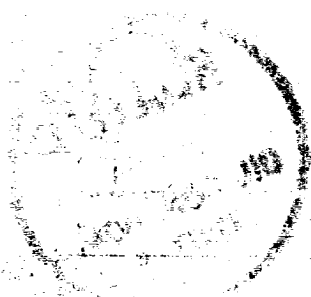

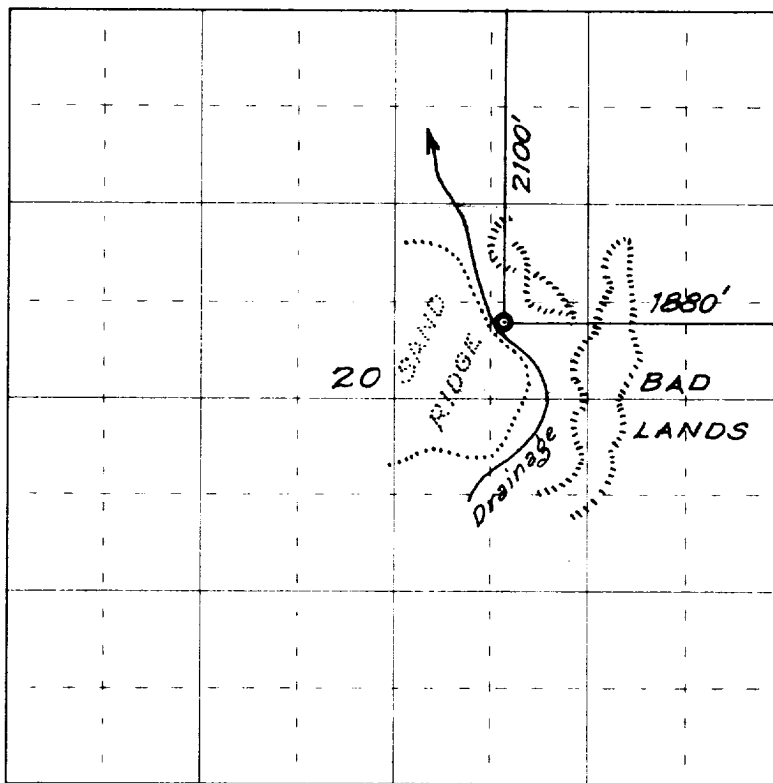
