6. If applicable, sand oil fracture with 30,000 gal crude oil and 100 gal sand.
7. Stub well into production, establish initial rate.

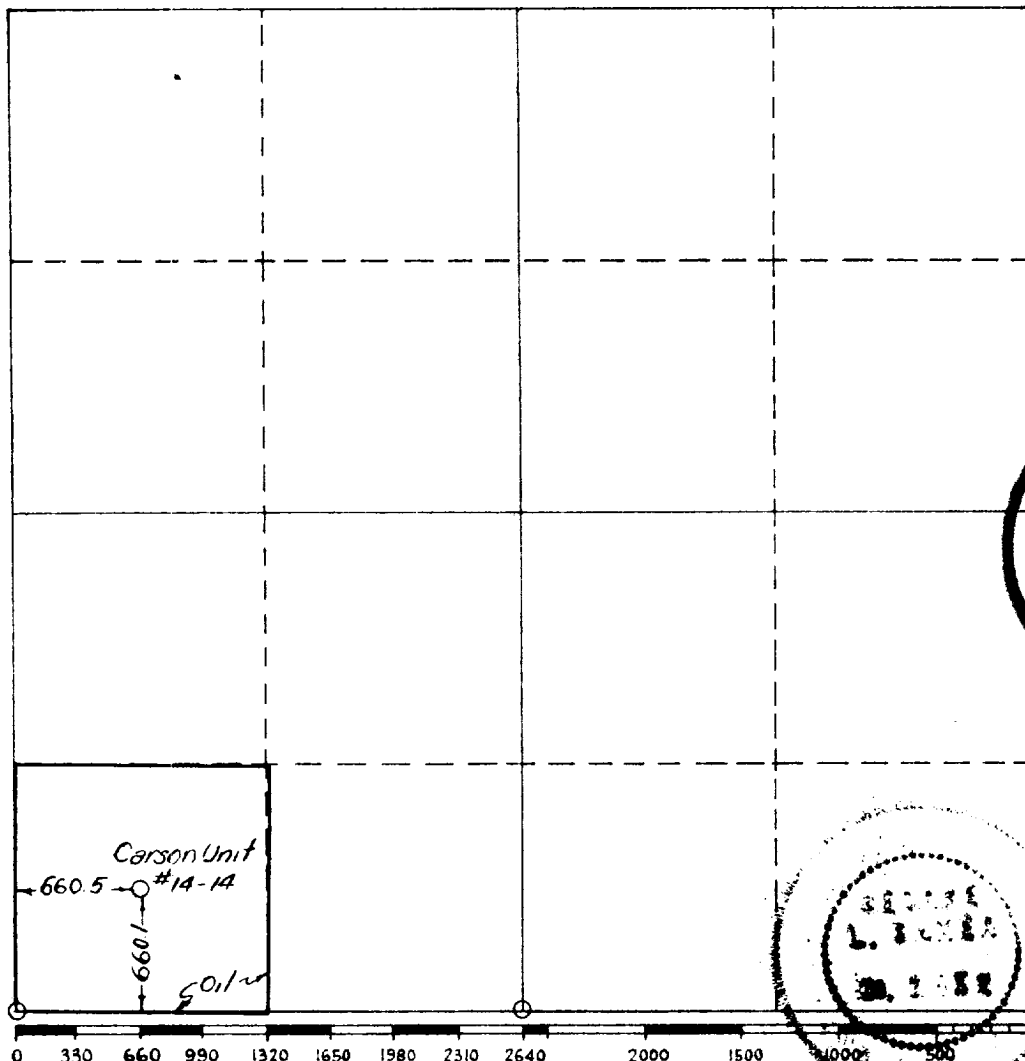
