DETAILS OF WORK

The 5 1/2" casing was perforated with 6 Lane Wells "B" bullets per ft. from 4873-30' and 4885-90'. The formation was fractured with 15,000# sand and 15,000 gal lease oil. We then set bridge plug at 4852' and perforated from 4816 to 4832. The formation was treated with 15,000# sand and 15,000 gal. of oil. The bridge plug was drilled and ran 2 3/8" tubing to 4900'. The well was swabbed to start flowing.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
