Dear Sir:

Reference is made to your letter of July 10, 1961 wherein you have stated that you intend to allocate the NW¹₄, SW¹₄ and W¹₂ NW¹₄ of Section 29-27N-1E to your #1 Betsy well.

The wildcat oil rules are based upon 40-acre well spacing. It is possible under the rule to add partial lots up to 20.49 acres to standard forties by administrative means; however your situation does not fit this requirement. Therefore it will be necessary that we proceed as follows:

We will reduce your acreage dedication to 24.3 acres and your allowable will be calculated on this basis until such time as you have taken up the matter of a non-standard unit in a hearing before the Commission. Your application for hearing for the non-standard unit should be addressed to Mr. A. L. Porter, Box 871, Santa Fe.
