5-30-63 TD 3130' MEH. Ran 98 joints 3104' of 5-1/2" OD 14# J-55 casing with left-hand thread pup joint 985.5' off bottom. Cemented with 50 sacks neat cement. Backed off at left-hand collar. Pailed 2179' of 5-1/2" casing, leaving 985.5' 5-1/2" casing for liner.

5-31-63 Temperature survey showed top of cement at 2800'.

Pailed liner dry. Ran correlation log. Found PMS at 3066' MEH.
