DETAILS OF WORK

- (1) Perforated 19 1/2 foot Gallup section from 7422 feet to 7440 feet.
- (2) Sand-Waterfraced with 50,000 gallons and 20,000# (20-40). Average injection rate 15 BPM. Pressure 2500-4000 psig.
- (3) Cleaned up frac water and sand to 7275 feet and tested 246 MCFD--only slight oil seum noted.
- (4) Placed cast iron bridge plug at 6000 feet with 25 feet cement on top.
- (5) Cut and pulled 4 1/2" liner from 5592 feet.
- (6) Cut and pulled 7 5/8" casing from 980 feet.
- (7) Placed 65 sacks cement plug 1100-900 feet and 10 sack plug at surface with regulation marker.
- (8) Filled between plugs with mud. F. & A 7-24-59.
