- A packer loakage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as pre-cribed by the order authorizing the are an completion. Such tests shall also be good-ordered as all put of completions within seven days following recompletion and/or obscuring or the test shall also be good-ordered as an whenever semodial work has been do so on a well during which the packer or the tubing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when required by the Division.
- 2. At least 72 hours prior to the commencement of any parties leafings test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so

- 7. Pressures for gas-zone tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauginat time intervals as follows: 3 hours tests: immediately prior to the beginning of eigh flow-period, at fifteen minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and authourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately pilor to the flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately as misway point) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Wher pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have pigriously shown questionable test data.
- 24-hour oil time tests: all pressures, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously impoured and recorded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which must be shecked at least twice, once at the beginning and once at the end of cach test, within deadweight pressure gauge. If a well is a gas-oil or an oil-gas dual completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadweight positiones as required above being taken on the gaz zone.
- 8. The resulting the above described tests shall be filed in triplicate within 15 days after completion of the test. Tests shall be filled with the Aztec District Office of the New Mession Oil Conservation Division of Northwest New Mexico Packer Leakage Test from Revised 10/01/78 with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures (gas zones only) and gravity and GOR (oil zones onlist.
