

THE APPLICATION OF EL PASO NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SAN JUAN 27-5 UNIT WELL NO. 52 LOCATED IN THE SW/4 SW/4 OF SECTION 4, TOWNSHIP 27 NORTH, RANGE 5 WEST, NMPM, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN SUCH A MANNER AS TO PERMIT THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM AN UNDESIGNATED PICTURED CLIFFS POOL AND THE PRODUCTION OF GAS FROM THE BLANCO-MESAVERDE POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) El Paso Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 30, 1960, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 52 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 12th day of December, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, El Paso Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 27-5 Unit Well No. 52 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 4, Township 27 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from an undesignated Pictured Cliffs Pool and the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

TION OF GAS FROM THE BISCUO-MEASAWAGE
POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A (c) of the
Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation
Commission on November 30, 1960, for permission to quarry
gas from San Juan 33-2 Unit Well No. 23 located in the SW\A SW\4 of
Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 2 Mile, MMPC, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY,
New Mexico, in such a manner as to benefit the production of gas
from an undesired Picturesque Cities Pool and the production of
gas from the Bisquo-Measawage Pool.

Now, on this fifth day of December, 1960, the necessary
Direction follows:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the
provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 115-A of the Commission's
Rules and Regulations;

(2) That geological information has been provided by
the operator of oilfield source has been duly furnished; and

(3) That no objection has been received within the
specified period as described by this rule.

(4) That the mechanics of said completion will not cause
waste nor impair corrective liquids.

(5) That the proposed said completion will be
designed and constructed with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application herein, of the Gas Company
be and this same is hereby accepted complete for San
Juan 33-2 Unit Well No. 23 located in the SW\A SW\4
Township 25 North, Range 2 Mile, MMPC, RIO ARRIBA COUNTY, NEW
MEXICO, in such a manner as to benefit the production of gas from
an undesired Picturesque Cities Pool and the production of gas from
the Bisquo-Measawage Pool primarily situated adjacent
to property.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That application shall be effective, otherwise
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section

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PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Blanco-Nesaverde Pool or as directed by the Secretary-Director of the Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That regulation of this
cause is hereby referred to the Commission for such further order
as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention
of waste and/or pollution of commerce regardless upon failure of
applicants to comply with any requirement of this order, the
Commission may permanently prohibit discharge and dredge
operations or the issuance and/or continuation of concessions
to reduce undue-zone propagation in the interests of conservation.
