This is to request a deliverability retest for the above referenced well.

The #103 is a Mesaverde completion which had its biannual deliverability test in March, 1987. At that time the well flowed 64 MCFD and had a deliverability of 61 MCFD. Recently, a compressor was installed and flow has stabilized at approximately 1000 MCFD. This new flowrate should result in a deliverability of approximately 700 MCFD.
