Order R-333-F, Section 1, Chapter 1, Paragraph B Reads as follows:

B. Within sixty days after a well is connected to a gas transportation facility the well shall have been tested in accordance with Section 1, Chapter 2 of these rules, "Initial Deliverability and Shut-In Pressure Tests Procedures", and the results filed with the Commission's Aztec office and with the gas transportation facility to which the well is connected. Failure to file said test within the above-prescribed sixty day period will subject the well to the loss of one day allowable for each day the test is late.

was initially connected to El Paso Natural Gas Co. 's pipeline on

7-28-70.

The initial test was therefore due 9-28-70 and has not been received as of this date.
