TEST FOR CASING LEAKS/ISOLATE BK PERFS

AART: K111 well w/15 KCL. NDMH, NUDOP.

QA: NTRUSU.

APRIL 8, 1987

AART: RIN w/tbg and pkr.

QA: K111 well w/15 KCL. NDMH, NUDOP. TOOH w/tbg. RIN 4-1/2" BP, 4-1/2" pkr. Set RSP at 7250'. Pull up 1 std. PT RSP to 1200 psi, held ok. Loaded BS, PT to 1000' taking fluid 3/4 BPM at 950. Pulled up to 5400, both sides taking fluid. Picked up and isolated the top leak at 464'. SDON.

APRIL 9, 1987

AART: RIN w/tbg, 3-7/8 bit & csg scraper.

QA: RIN w/tbg and 4-1/2" pkr, isolate btm leak at 5757'. RIN w/tbg to 6000'. Spot 2 sz of sand on top of RSP. Pull up to 5516'. Spot 30 sz of Class B with 6/105 of B-60 fluid loss. Set pkr, squeeze hole with 28 sz of cement. Final sq pressure 1550 psi, no leak off. POOH w/tbg and pkr. TIN w/tbg and spot 30 sz of Class B cement w/.05 B-60 fluid loss and .4% of B-65 friction reducer. POOH w/tbg. Pump down csg. Cement locked up w/8 sz outside csg. RIN w/tbg to 427'. Reversed out excess cement. POOH w/tbg. Repressured to 500 psi, held ok. SDON.

APRIL 10, 1987

CASING REPAIR

AART: RIN w/tbg and retrieving head.

QA: RIN w/tbg and 3-7/8 bit. Tag cement at 420'. Drilled squeeze. Circulated clean. PT 500 psi, held ok. RIN w/tbg to 5715'. Drilled squeeze, circulated clean. Run down to 5880'. PT to 500 psi, held ok. POOH w/tbg and bit. RIN w/tbg and retrieving head. Tag bridge at 5940'. POOH w/tbg and retrieving head. RIN w/tbg and bit. Washed cement and sand down to RSP @ 7250'. Did not have to drill it. POOH w/tbg and bit. SDON.

APRIL 13, 1987

AART: Well back on production.

QA: RIN w/tbg, retrieving head. CO to RSP w/foam. Released plug. K111 tbg. POOH w/tbg and RSP. RIN w/4-1/2" CIBP on wireline. Set plug on 7390'. POOH w/setting tool. RIN w/tbg. Landed at 7366' w/1.78 ID SN 1 jt off btm. NUDOP, NDMH. Kick well around with nitrogen. Shut well in.

FINAL TDS DETAIL: 248 jts 2-3/8, J-55, ENE, BRD, 4.7, 7356.82 w/1.78 ID SN 1 jt off btm.
