NORTHWEST NEWMEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

- A packet leakage test shall be commenced on each mortiply completed well within 14 (1) paster transporters and a communication many properties.

 Secondays after actual completion of the well and annually transporter as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completion. Such tests small also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and or chemical or fracture treatment, and whenever temedial work has been done on a well caring which the packet or the tubing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when reducated by the Division.
- At least 72 hours pix is to the commencement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so notified
- The packer leasure test shall commence when not nizones of the dual completion are shat-in for pressure stubilization. Both zones sata terrain shat-in until the well-head pressure in each has stabilized, provided however, that they reed not remain shat-in more
- . For Flow Test No. 1, one who of the disal completion shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other rong remains state of Nach test shall be continued for seven days at the case of a glassical and for 24 hours in the case of an outsea. - Flow Test No. 2 small re-conducted even to suportion and was addicated on ing Flow No. 1. Procedure for Flow Test No. 2 is to be the same as for Flow Test No. 2 except

- that the previously produced zone shall remain shut-in while the zone which was previously shut-in is produced
- Pressures for gas-zone tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours tests: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at fifteen-minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hourly of each flow period. "I-day tests immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period." least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and immediately prior to the condusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable test data. 24-hour oil zone tests, all pressures throughout the entire test shall be commutously measured and recorded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which must be checked at least twice, once at the beginning and once at the end of each test, with a deep decided recognition.
- deadweight pressure gauge. If a well is a gas-oil or an oil-gas dual completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadweight pressures as required above being taken on the gas zone
- The results of the above-described tests shall be filed in triplicate within 15 days after completion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico. Oil Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Packer Leakage Test form Revised 10-(1-78 with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures (gas zones only) and gravity and GOR (oil zones only)
