It is proposed to change the status on this well to long term shut-in. The well is currently being evaluated in a geologic study encompassing the area around this well. In view of the production history of this well as compared to surrounding wells, this well should have additional recoverable reserves. It is believed these reserves can only be recovered by the installation of pumping equipment. Because of existing natural gas prices, it is not economically feasible to install such equipment at this time. It is therefore requested this well be approved for long term shut-in status for the following reasons:

1. The well is currently unable to buck line pressure.
2. The well is unable to produce in paying quantities under current market conditions.
3. The well has additional reserves and has the potential to produce again if market conditions and/or line pressure change, or if pumping equipment can be economically installed.
