Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices. In addition, such proposals and reports should include reasons for the abandonment; data on any former or present productive zones, or other zones with present significant fluid contents not sealed off by cement or otherwise; depths (top and bottom) and method of placement of cement plugs; mud or other material placed below, between and above plugs; amount, size, method of parting of any casing, liner or tubing pulled and the depth to top of any left in the hole; method of closing top of well; and date well site conditioned for final inspection looking to approval of the abandonment.

GUIDE TO THE ABANDONMENT OF WELLS

This guide is intended to provide information to the well owner or operator regarding the requirements for the abandonment of wells on Federal and Indian lands.

The following information is intended to provide a general overview of the requirements for the abandonment of wells. Specific requirements may vary from State to State and from well to well.

The first step in the abandonment process is to determine the requirements for the abandonment of the well in the State or Federal jurisdiction in which the well is located.

The second step is to prepare a proposal for the abandonment of the well. The proposal should include the following information:

1. A description of the well, including its location, depth, and production history.

2. A description of the reasons for the abandonment of the well.

3. A description of the proposed method of abandonment, including the type of cement to be used, the depth of the cement plug, and the method of sealing the well.

4. A description of the proposed method of conditioning the well site for final inspection.

5. A description of the proposed method of monitoring the well after abandonment.

6. A description of the proposed method of maintaining the well site.

7. A description of the proposed method of disposing of the well site.

8. A description of the proposed method of restoring the well site.

9. A description of the proposed method of reusing the well site.

10. A description of the proposed method of recycling the well site.

11. A description of the proposed method of redeveloping the well site.

12. A description of the proposed method of reestablishing the well site.

13. A description of the proposed method of reorganizing the well site.

14. A description of the proposed method of restructuring the well site.

15. A description of the proposed method of reintegrating the well site.

16. A description of the proposed method of reinserting the well site.

17. A description of the proposed method of reintroducing the well site.
