O. H. Randel Well No. 4 was originally completed in July, 1964, as a marginal Dakota gas well testing 1500 MCFD. Due to excessive water production the well would not produce into the pipeline and was subsequently recompleted in the Gallup formation as a pumping oil well in April, 1966, testing 8 BOPD. As a result of this low production, making it uneconomical to hook up to the pipeline, we plan to plug and abandon the well as follows:

1. Spot 50 sacks cement containing 6% Gel and 2% calcium chloride from PBD 5500' to approximately 5175' (perfs 5286-5304; 5310-20; 5356-76 and 5418-52') and squeeze.
2. Load hole with fluid and spot 75 sacks cement with 6% Gel and 2% calcium chloride from 4350' to 2800',
3. Load hole with fluid and spot 10 sacks cement from 1500-1400'.
4. Load hole with fluid and spot 5 sacks cement with 6% Gel and 2% calcium chloride from surface to 50'.
5. Pump 50 sacks cement with 6% Gel and 2% calcium chloride into 8-5/8" - 4-1/2" casing annulus.
6. Cut off wellhead, erect PXA marker, and clean up location.
