Drilled to 2144' with rotary tools. On 5/4/55 set 5-1/2" OD 14# J-55 casing at 2142' RKB with 100 sacks coment. Moved fotary off.

After moving cable tools on, made 3 hour water test on 5/10/55. Showed no water. Flowed 170 mcf/d. Drilled to 2203. On 5/12/55 sand oil treated with 8000 gallons diesel oil and 11,300# sand. Flushed with 2500 gallons. Injection rate 23.7 EPM. Well unloaded and, after 2 hours, flowed at rate of 15,000 MDF/d.

Cleaned out, and on 5/14/55 ran 71 joints of 1" tubing to 2182". Shut well in for potential test.
