

Dear Mr. Hering:

Reference is made to your application dated September 7, 1990 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Day "B" Well No. 6 which was drilled in 1960 and completed in the South Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool at a standard gas well location 1700 feet from the North line and 1750 feet from the West line (Unit F) of Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that the Pictured Cliffs zone will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, is unorthodox. Further, Lots 1 through 4 and the E/2 W/2 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 7 shall be dedicated to the well forming a standard 320.44-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Division Order No. R-8768, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
