We have your letter of August 17, 1970, requesting approval of production for a thirty day testing period for the Southern Gulf Production Co., Navajo #4 well located in the southwest quarter of Section 10, Township 26 North, Range 18 West, San Juan County.

You are hereby authorized to produce and transport oil and gas from this well for a thirty day period commencing August 21, 1970, and ending September 30, 1970. Any production beyond September 30 will not be authorized until a non standard location order has been entered by the Commission approving the location.
