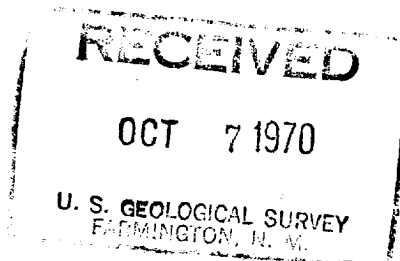
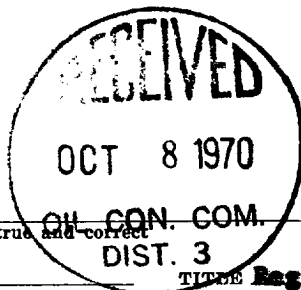

Ran 12 jts of 13-3/8" casing set at 389.57'. Cemented w/440 sacks and
cement was circulated to surface.**

**9/18/70 Nipped up and tested blowout preventer and casing to 1000 psi for one
hour and held O.K. Drilled out from under surface casing w/11" hole at
6:30 PM on 9/17/70.**

**9/19/70 Drilled 11" hole to 944' and reduced hole size to 7-7/8". Well condi-
tions are such that the string of 8-5/8" casing initially proposed will
be eliminated and well will proceed toward objective depth of 6625'.**

Instructions
