Reference is made to your well No. 117 San Juan 28-7 Unit, SW\s\S\\\\ Sec. 6, T. 27 N., R. 7 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Lease SF-078835 and your Sundry Notice approved on July 5, 1991. This well has been approved for plugging for over a year. If the well has been plugged, you are required to submit a subsequent report of abandonment.
