This well was originally approved as a Basin Dakota gas well. However, once the well was cased and tested, the Dakota was found to be nonproductive. Therefore the Dakota perforations were squeezed with 150 sacks Neat cement, and the well was reperforated in the Chacra formation to test for productivity. The Chacra was tested and found to be economically productive, therefore the well was completed as a Chacra gas well. This necessitates changing the well name from the Federal 16E to the Federal #21.
