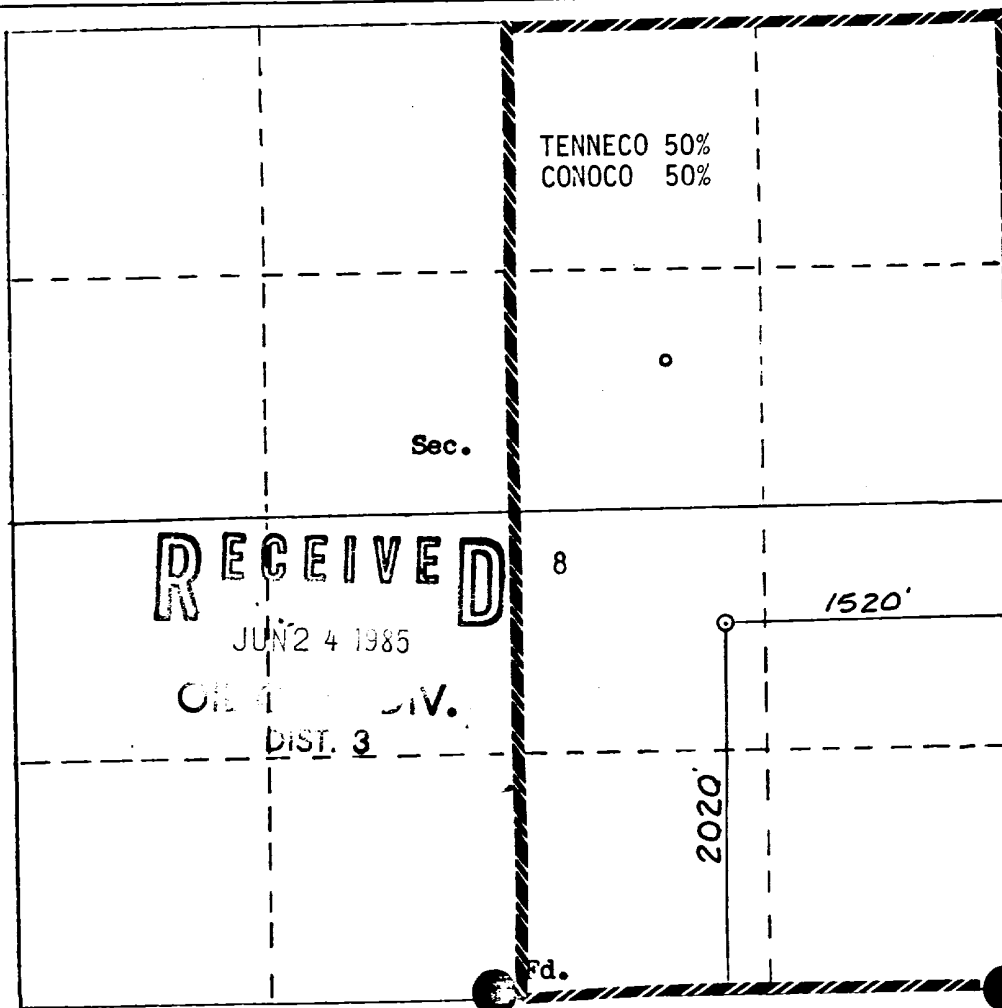

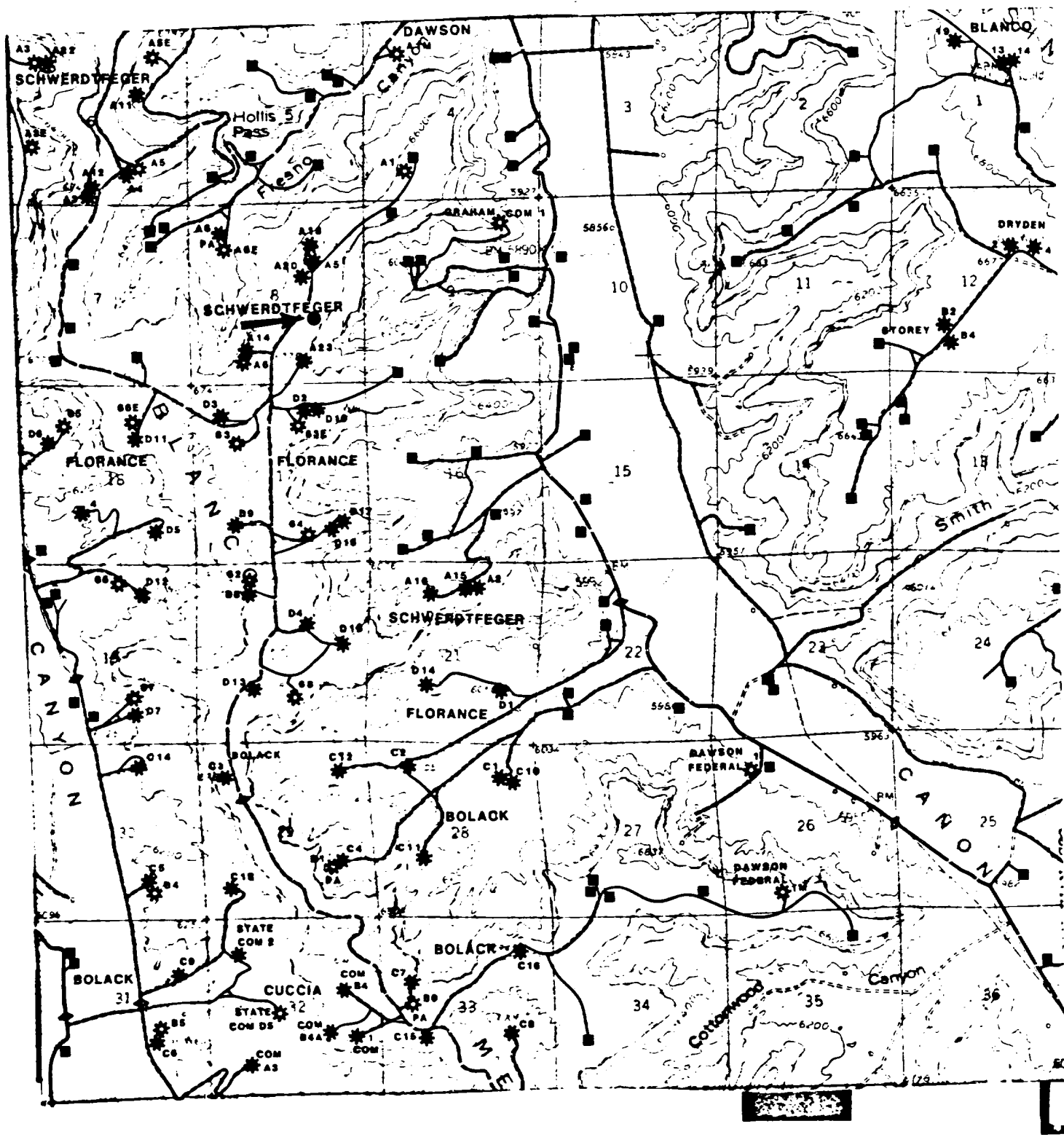

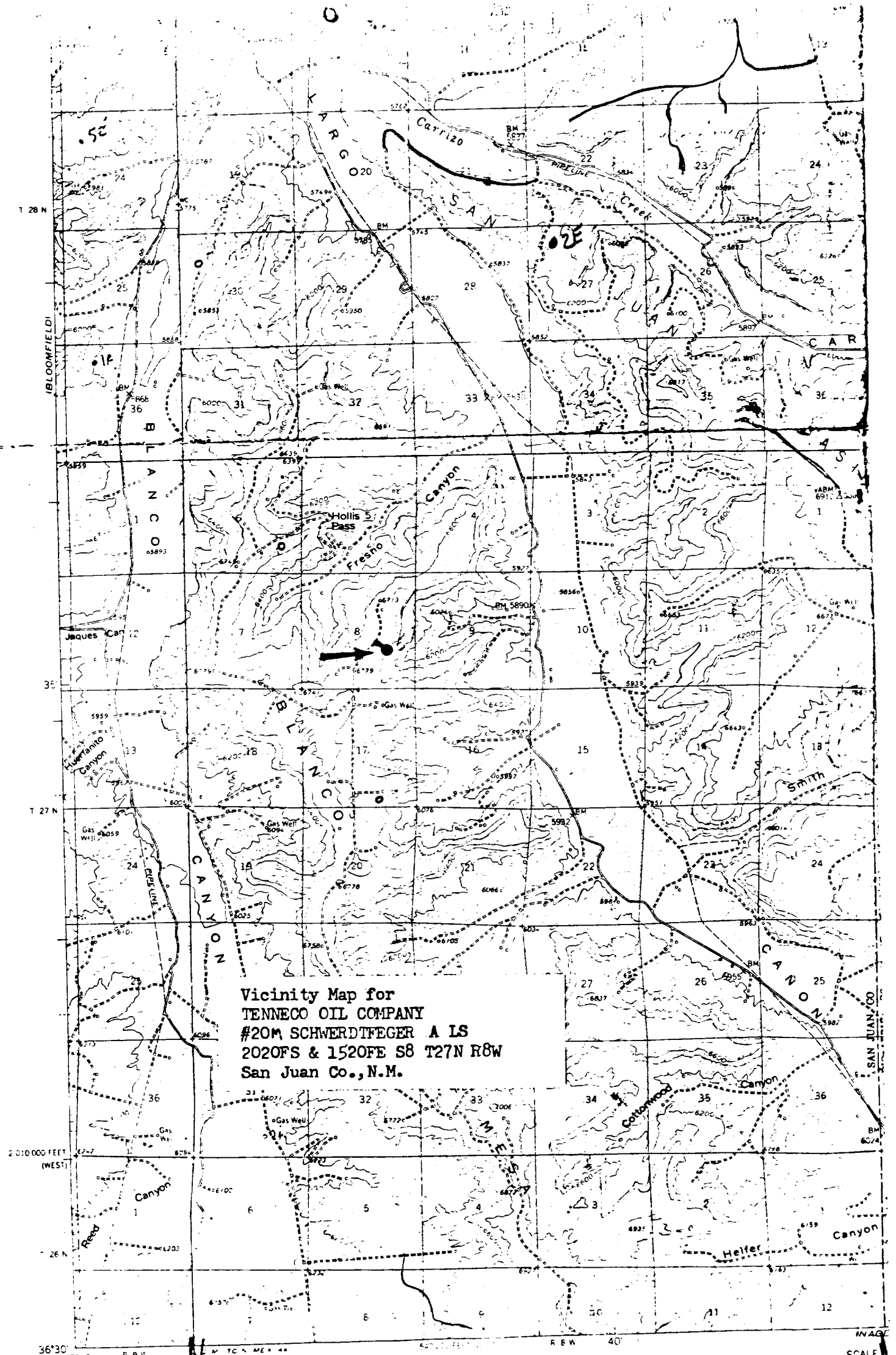

San Juan Co., N.M.

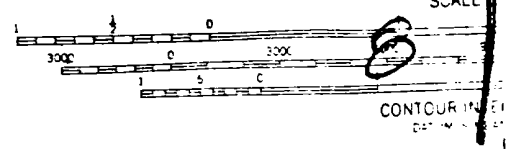
