06/30/89 Made bit and scraper run. Rolled hole with 2% KCL water and pressure tested casing to 3500 psi. Rigged up Blue Jet and perforated from 1320'-1329', 1383'-1401', and 1419'-1427' with 4 JSPF. Shot a total of 120 holes. Swabbed well. Shut down for night.  
07/01/89 Repairing rig. Shut down for night.  
07/02/89 Shut down for Sunday.  
07/03/89 Swab tested well. Shut down for night.  
07/04/89 Shut down for the holiday.  
07/05/89 Rigged up Western and fraced well with 14,000# 20/40 Br sand and 90,000 gallons of 70 Quality Foam. Flowed well back. Shut down for night.
