Propose to drill to estimated total depth 7980', set 7" liner from 3450 to 7550  
 Cement W/425 sx reg. W/4 $\frac{1}{2}$  gal and 1/4 $\frac{1}{2}$  floccs per sack.  
 Set 5" liner from 7450 to 7980 Cement W/50 sx reg.  
 Perforate Dakota and frac using approx. 40,000 gal water 30,000 $\frac{1}{2}$  sand.  
 Perforate Mesaverde and frac using approx. 150,000 gal water and 50,000 $\frac{1}{2}$  sand.  
 Clean out and dually complete well in Mesaverde and Dakota.
