

Dear Sir:

This is to inform you that El Paso Natural Gas Company has changed plans for the dual completion of our San Juan 28-7 Unit No. 68 Well in the NE/4 of Section 31, Township 28 North, Range 7 West.

We originally dually completed this well in the Pictured Cliffs-Mesa Verde. Subsequent tests showed communication between the formations via a hole in the tubing. Upon attempted repair it was found that the Pictured Cliffs formation was producing water and not a commercial quantity of gas. Subsequently the Pictured Cliffs formation has now been squeezed off and this well completed in the Mesa Verde only.
