

Re: Application for Exception to Rule 6 (a) of Order No. R-565 for Non-Standard Proration Unit, Fulcher-Kutz - Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

El Paso Natural Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard proration unit comprising the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) (or SE/4 NW/4, NE/4 NW/4, Lots 1 and 2) of Section 7. Township 27 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- 1. The Pipkin #2 Well, located 1650' from the South line and 990' from the East line of Section 7, Township 27 North, Range 10 West, was completed as a gas well on April 30, 1951, and connected to El Paso Natural Gas Company's gathering system December 20, 1951.
- 2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 166.31 acres which are contiguous quarter-quarter sections and lots.
- 3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single government section.
- 4. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas.
- 5. That by copy of this letter of application all operators owning interests (a) in the section in which any part of the non-standard proration unit is situated and which acreage is not included in said non-standard gas proration unit, and (b) in acreage offsetting the non-standard gas proration unit, are notified by registered mail of this proposed non-standard gas proration unit.

Therefore, El Paso Natural Gas Company requests that under the provision of Rule 6 (b) Revised of Order No. R-565, the Secretary of the Commission grant exception to Rule 6 (a) without Notice and Hearing, and approve the subject non-standard gas proration unit.


