FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On October 26, 1950 at 4:00 A. M., 36 hours will have elapsed since cementing the 8-5/8" casing at 114' with 100 sacks cement. The cement circulated to surface.

At that time, casing will be tested with approximately 500 psi for 30 minutes. Cement will be drilled in bottom of pipe and water shut-off tested with approximately 500 psi for 30 minutes.

If satisfactory tests are obtained, drilling will be resumed.
