DETAILS OF WORK

The well was shot 8-25-51 with 218 quarts of solidified nitro glycerin from 1612-1702.

The shot went off on time and the calseal plug was drilled, and the well cleaned out to the total depth of 1702'. When the well was shut in the gas flow was estimated at 4 million cubic feet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
