## NORTHWEST NEW MEDICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

1. A parker leakage test shall be commenced on each multiply completed well within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and/or chemical of fracture measurement, and whenever remedial work has been done on a well during which the packer or the subseng have been dissurbed. Tests shall also be taken as any time that commitments into precise or whenever developed by the Division.

- At least 72 hours prior to the commencement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall notify the Division on writing of the exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so notified.
- 3 The packer leakage test shall commence when both sones of the dual completion are shut-in (or pressure stabilization. Both zones shall remain shut-an until the well-head pressure in each has suabilized, provided however, that they need not remain shut-in more than seven days.
- 4. For Flow Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal rate of production while the other zone remains shut-in. Such test shall be continued for seven dars in the case of a gas well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Note: if, on an initial packer testage test, a gas well is being flowed to the atmosphere due to the lack of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be three hours.
- 5. Following complexion of Flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shur-in, in accordance with Paragraph 5 above.
- 6. Flow Test No. 2 shall be conducted even though no leak was indicated during Flow Test No. 1. Procedure for Flow Test No. 2 is to be the same as for Flow Test No. 1 except

- that the previously produced some small remain shales the some which was previously shot-in is produced.
- 7. Pressures for gen-sone rests must be measured on easth sone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours tent: immended prior to the beginning of each flow-period, is fifteen-manuae interval during the first hour thereof, and as hourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. 7-day even: immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and immerciately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on well which have previously shown questionable test data.

24-hour oil zone reru: all prezuares, throughout the extrine text, shall be continuously measured and recorded with recording pressur gauges that accuracy of which must be thereof at least revier, once at the beginning and once at the end of each text, with a deadwarette pressure gauge, if a well in a guardier to noin-gan dual completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil zone only, with deadwarette pressures as required as the oil zone only, with deadwarette pressures as required above being eaken on the gas noise.

8. The results of the above-described test shall be filed in criplicate within 13 days ofter completion of the rest. Tests shall be filed with the Asset District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Packet Leskage Test Form Revised 10-01-78 with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatures (gas zones only) and gravity and GOR (oil mostes only).
