#### Gentlemen:

Enclosed are your Applications for Permit to Drill (APD's) the following wells:

- 1. No. 3 Navajo 5, NE/4NE/4 section 5, T. 26 N., R. 19 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease NOO-C-14-20-4157
- 2. No. 2 Navajo Nation 33, NW/4SW/4 section 33, T. 27 N., R. 19 W., San Juan County, New Mexico, lease NOG (Operating Agreement)

As discussed with Al Kendrick of your company on July 17, 1990, the subject APD's are rescinded and returned due to drilling not being commenced within one year of the approval date.

If this office does not receive comment within 30 days, we will presume that no construction occurred and proceed accordingly.
