DETAILS OF WORK

It is intended to mud drill with rotary tools thru the Dakota Formation. Possible producing zones will be perforated and fractured. Est. T. D. 7875'.

Casing Program:

- 10 3/4" set at 280' w/220 sks. cement - 200% to circulate.
- 4 1/2" set at 7875' with 2 stage tool set 50' below base of Point Lookout and 3 stage tool set 50' below base of Pictured Cliffs.
- First stage w/300 sks. - 150% to cover 100' above Gallup top.
- Second Stage w/290 sks. - 150% to cover above Cliff House top.
- Third Stage w/340 sks. - 150% to cover 100' above Rio Alamo.

The E/2 of Section 21 is dedicated to this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

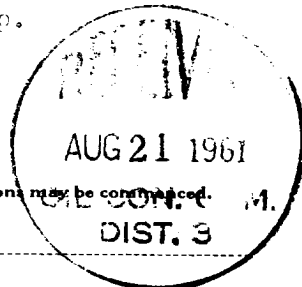

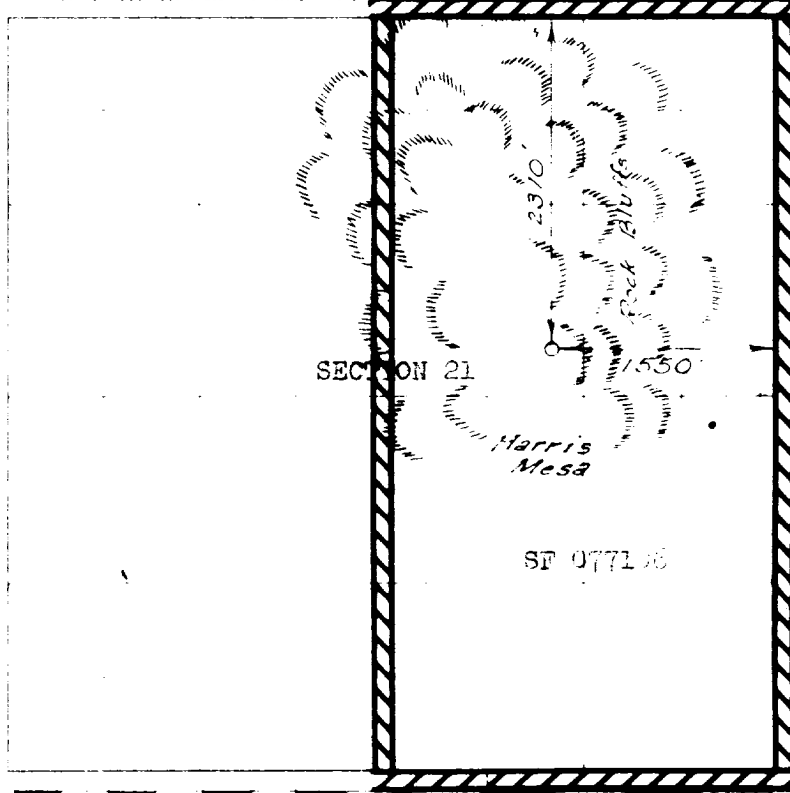
