This will refer to Pan American Petroleum Corporation's Day Gas Unit No. 1 Dakota well located 990 feet from the south line and 1190 feet from the east line of Section 7, T-28-N, R-10-W, in the Angels Peak Dakota Field, San Juan County, New Mexico.

In accordance with the administrative procedure outlined by Order No. R-1628-A, it is respectfully requested that a non-standard gas unit comprising all of partial Section 7 and the W/2 W/2 of partial Section 8, T-28-N, R-10-W, a total of 321.95 acres, be established in the Dakota producing interval for the Day Gas Unit No. 1. The attached copy of Form C-128 shows the proposed acreage dedication for the non-standard unit.

A communitization agreement pertaining to all of partial Section 7 and the W/2 W/2 of partial Section 8, T-28-N, R-10-W, San Juan County, New Mexico, has been executed by all parties and forwarded to the United States Geological Survey for their handling and final approval.

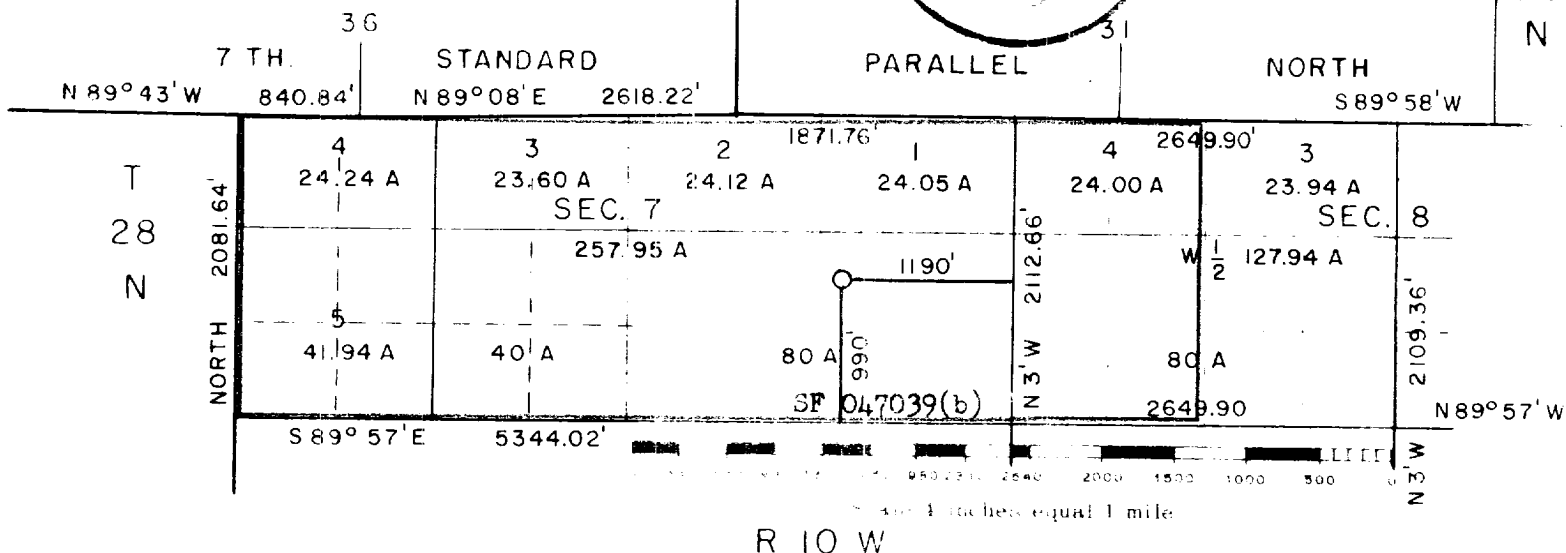
