5 1/2" @ 4515' with 150 sacks cement.

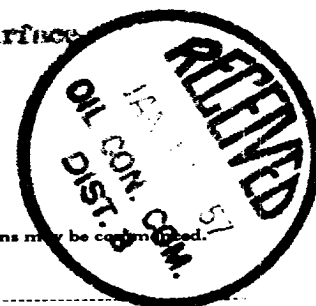

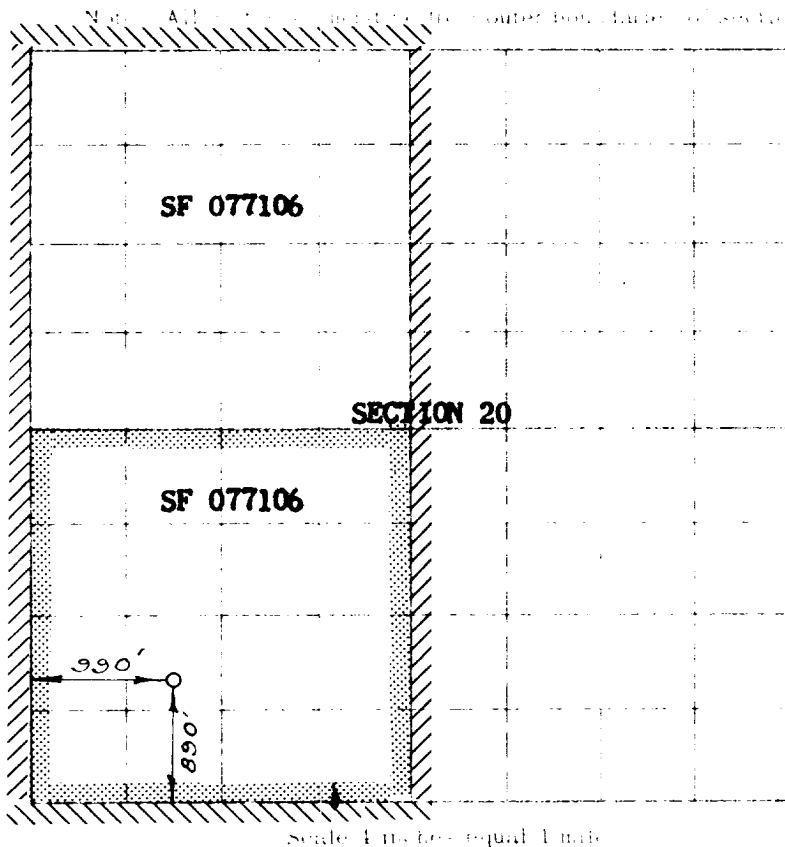
