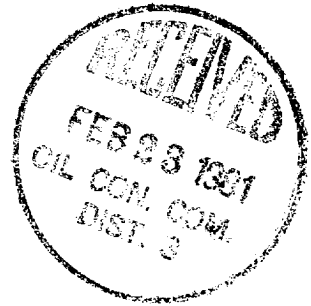

Gentlemen:

Supron Energy Corporation desires to drill a well to be named the Angel Peak number 24 to be located 1874 feet from the South line and 1790 feet from the East line of partial Section 10, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M., of San Juan County. We desire to drill this well and complete it in the Astec pool and the Fruitland formation.

The acreage dedication is on a non standard location being only 270 feet from the North section line. We do not believe that this proposed well can be moved from the above described location as this particular formation sand can only be found in very isolated spots. We have attached a plat showing the proposed acreage to be dedicated to this well. The Fruitland zone was discovered during the drilling of our Angel Peak number 5-R well, previously approved for drilling to a deeper formation, 60 feet West of this proposed location.

It is requested that Supron Energy Corporation be granted approval to drill the Angel Peak number 24 well on a non standard footage location and drilling unit due to the fact that we reasonable could not be expected to complete a commercial well in this formation by moving a greater distance away from the known zone.

We have attached a plat showing the offset operators. These offset operators have been notified of our intention by Certified mail on February 18, 1981. We also have attached a topography plat of the subject area, taken from the Bloomfield Quadrangle.
